Sample EIN Letter

WE ASSIGNED YOU AN EMPLOYER IDENTIFICATION NUMBER

Thank you for applying for an Employer Identification Number (EIN). We assigned you EIN 27-0520584. This EIN will identify you, your business accounts, tax returns, and documents, even if you have no employees. Please keep this notice in your permanent records.

When filing tax documents, payments, and related correspondence, it is very important that you use your EIN and complete name and address exactly as shown above. Any variation may cause a delay in processing, result in incorrect information in your account, or even cause you to be assigned more than one EIN. If the information is not correct as shown above, please make the correction using the attached tear off stub and return it to us.

Assigning an EIN does not grant tax-exempt status to non-profit organizations. Publication 557, *Tax Exempt Status for Your Organization*, has details on the application process, as well as information on returns you may need to file. To apply for formal recognition of tax-exempt status, most organizations will need to complete either Form 1023, *Application for Recognition of Exemption Under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code*, or Form 1024, *Application for Recognition of Exemption Under Section 501(a)*. 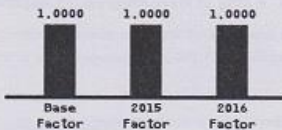

Filing due dates

Your taxes must be filed **monthly**. Monthly filers are required to file and pay taxes electronically (e-file). All future correspondence from us will be sent electronically to your secure My DOR online account.

Returns are due the 25th of the month following the taxable period. For example, your tax return for the month of January is due on February 25th. When a due date falls on a weekend or legal holiday, the due date extends to the next business day. You must file a tax return each month, even if you do not have business activity to report.

Electronic filing requirement

You are required to file and pay electronically (RCW 82.32.080). Go to dor.wa.gov/mandatory-e-file for more information.

Dear Licensee:

Based on the information on your My DOR account and recent Business License Application or renewal, JEFF TAYLOR has been assigned as a My DOR Administrator.

A My DOR Administrator has full control over your My DOR account, so only owners or governing people should be Administrators. Every business account must have an Administrator.

Manage user access

Administrators can control user access and assign Account Managers for others, such as bookkeepers or registered agents. Account Managers have access to only the accounts you choose and can't give access to others. We recommend Administrators check who has access to their account regularly.
